- The form is then sent by March 31, 2023, to your District Interact Chair to "sign", certifying the club is in good standing. **Do not send form to Rotary International!**

District Interact Chair may forward the completed form by email from his/her email account; this meets the requirement of the District Chair "signing" the award. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
